These latter are printed in italics, or in the type used for the text. It is hoped that by this means confusion will be avoided, and that the reader will become familiar with the international names, even if, in some cases, he prefers to adhere to the older English terms. All the illustrations have been drawn by Mr. J. T. Murray, so well known as an anatomical artist, to whom I am deeply indebted for the great...
